These programs also allow us the opportunity to speak with them about new benefits and services," said SDDVA Secretary Greg Whitlock. "As the advocates for South Dakota veterans, we

MILITARY HONORS CEREMONY FOR UNACCOMPANIED VETERANS

The Black Hills National Cemetery will host its quarterly Military Honors Ceremony for Unaccompanied Veterans on Monday, April 1, 2024, at 9:00 am (MT).

This ceremony provides military funeral honors to those veterans interred at the cemetery over the previous quarter, who did not have honors at the time of burial. The South Dakota Army National Guard from Camp Rapid and Sturgis Volunteer Honor Guard Post 33 will be performing honors.

The ceremony will be held at the Black Hills National Cemetery Committal Shelter near the main flagpole (20902 Pleasant Valley Drive) in Sturgis.

VIETNAM COMMEMORATION CEREMONY

The Black Hills National Cemetery will host a Vietnam Commemoration Ceremony on Friday, March 29, 2024 at 10:00am (MT).

This commemoration recognizes all men and women who served on active duty in the U.S. Armed Forces during the U.S. involvement in Vietnam—November 1, 1955, to May 15, 1975. The Vietnam War commemoration is a long-overdue opportunity for all Americans to recognize, honor, and thank our Vietnam Veterans and their families for their service and sacrifices during one of America's longest wars.

The ceremony will be held at the Black Hills National Cemetery Committal Shelter (20901 Pleasant Valley Drive) in Sturgis (near the main flag pole).







The Power of Choice

The Inspiring Story of Melissa Stockwell, an Army Veteran and Paralympic Athlete Melissa Stockwell served as a Second Lieutenant in the US Army, and was deployed to Baghdad, Iraq in March 2004. Sadly, just three weeks into her deployment, a roadside bomb hit her Humvee causing the loss of her left leg above the knee. After undergoing several surgeries to recover from multiple infections, Melissa was honorably discharged from the Army. As the first female soldier to lose a limb in active combat, she was awarded both The Bronze Star Medal and the Purple Heart.

Despite the tragic incident, Melissa turned to sports for recovery. She made history in April 2008 by becoming the first Iraqi War Veteran to qualify for the Beijing Paralympics. She then shifted her focus to Paratriathlon and went on to become a three-time World Champion. Her talent and hard work led her to win the Paralympic Bronze Medal at the Paralympic Games in Rio de Janeiro on September 11, 2016.
