## HONORING AND HEALING

2015 will mark the 40th anniversary of the end of the Vietnam War. The Vietnam Vets / Legacy Vets Motorcycle Club and the Sioux Falls Vets council will host the event, "40 Years of Honoring and Healing", in Sioux Falls, SD August 5-9, 2015. The event will include a police escort to the wall site traveling north on Minnesota Ave, from the VFW, to the event site, Sanford Pentagon Sports Complex, on Aug 5<sup>th</sup>. The event is open to the public, and will also include opening and closing ceremonies.

The event site will display the American Veterans Traveling Tribute (AVTT) Traveling Wall. This replica is 80 percent scale version of the Vietnam Memorial Wall in Washington D.C. Across its 360-foot length the Wall contains every single name etched on the original. At its apex the memorial is an impressive eight feet tall. The Traveling Wall was completed in early 1998 and began traveling that year, and over 58,000 fallen soldiers, sailors, airmen, and marines are listed on the wall. This event is open to the public.

Dave Hodgson, event organizer explains, "This gives an opportunity for those who sacrificed so much the chance to remember their fallen brothers and sisters, as well as the public an opportunity to honor and thank our heroes who served in Vietnam."

The American Veterans Traveling Tribute is a veteran-owned project committed to travel the USA to honor, respect, and remember those who served, and pay specific tribute to those who gave all.

AVTT is not government sponsored or affiliated, but funded through sponsorship fees, donations, and sale of merchandise at events. AVTT is self-funded via sponsorship fees, merchandise sales, and donations. AVTT is contracted by The Texas Freedom Tribute (TFT,) an IRS designated 501 C3, to provide The Wall, crew, and expertise. Donations or support to AVTT's mission via TFT are qualified charitable tax deductions.

## SIoux FALLS NATIONAL GUARD UNIT TO DEPLOY TO KUWAIT

The South Dakota Army National Guard's 196th Maneuver Enhancement Brigade has received an official mobilization order for deployment to Kuwait in support of Operation Enduring Freedom - Spartan Shield.

Thirty-nine soldiers from the Sioux Falls-based unit are scheduled for a nine-month deployment beginning in late February 2016. While in Kuwait, the soldiers will conduct force protection and security operations.

The unit will report to Fort Bliss, Texas, to complete several weeks of theater-specific training prior to deployment overseas. This will be the second mobilization for the 196th, which deployed to Afghanistan in support of Operation Enduring Freedom in 2010-2011.
