KOREAN WAR VETERANS TO RECEIVE AMBASSADOR FOR PEACE MEDALS

South Dakota will honor Korean War Veterans with an "Ambassador for Peace" medal ceremony Tuesday, Jan. 12, 2016, in Pierre.

The South Dakota Department of Veterans Affairs (SDDVA), in collaboration with the Republic of Korea, will be hosting the event which begins at 2:30 p.m. (CST) in the Capitol Rotunda.

The "Ambassador for Peace" medal is bestowed in an expression of appreciation from the people of the Republic of Korea for those who served in Korea's land, air and sea from Jun. 25, 1950 through Oct. 25, 1954.

"It has been an honor to work side by side with the MVPA on this ceremony," said Larry Zimmerman, Secretary of the South Dakota Department of Veterans Affairs. "They recognize what these heroes have given and as a token of their sincerest appreciation they will present them with an Ambassador for Peace Medal which symbolizes their adoration and appreciation for their service and sacrifice."

The ceremony will include remarks from Gov. Dennis Daugaard, SDDVA Secretary Larry Zimmerman, and the Honorable Sungchoon Park, Minister of the Ministry of Patriots and Veterans Affairs (MVPA). Sunny Lee, advisor of MPVA will also recognize surviving MIA families.

"I look forward to being a part of the ceremony to recognize South Dakota's Korean War Veterans," said Gov. Dennis Daugaard. "Though no amount of recognition or awards can fully compensate for the service these men and women have wrought, it will be a very special and meaningful event."

Many of our county and tribal veterans service officers and our service organizations will be hosting events in their communities to recognize and honor those veterans who are unable to travel.

NAME CHANGE FOR VA OEF/OIF/OND PROGRAM

Janet Murphy, Office of the Acting Under Secretary for Health for Operations and Management, has announced a name change for what we now refer to as the OEF/OIF/OND Program:

The OEF/OIF/OND Care Management Program will now be known as the Transition and Care Management (TCM) Program. They note this change will more accurately reflect the purpose, target population, and future vision of providing care and case management not just to veterans who served in combat supporting OEF/OIF/OND, but also to post 9/11 veterans who need care management. To reflect the purpose, target population and future vision, VAMC teams will be renamed to TCM.
