South Dakota Veterans Commission Elects Officers for Coming Year

PIERRE, S.D. – The South Dakota Veterans Commission elected new officers to lead the Commission in enhancing the lives of South Dakota veterans.

Helen Parr of Sioux Falls was elected as chairman, and Lori Vosika of Hot Springs was selected as vice chairman. Parr succeeds Chairman Jim Ross of Whitewood.

"The Commission has made history," said Larry Zimmerman, Secretary of the South Dakota Department of Veterans Affairs. "We have three female and three male commissioners and for the first time in the history of the Commission, both leadership positions are commanded by female commissioners."
