VISN 23 TO HOST MENTAL HEALTH SUMMIT

The VA will be hosting a VISN 23 Mental Health Summit on May 2, 2025. This year's theme, "Moral Injury Healing: Confronting the War Within," focuses on addressing the deep, often unseen wounds carried by many veterans and those who care for them.

The summit is free, virtual, and open to everyone — veterans, their supporters, VA staff, community partners, and healthcare professionals alike. The event will feature a robust agenda including insights from VISN leadership, a dedicated moral injury panel, and presentations from subject matter experts covering evidence-based treatments like Acceptance and Commitment Therapy for Moral Injury (ACT-MI), Trauma Informed Guilt Reduction Therapy, and Building Spiritual Strength.
