# RECIPIENTS OF THE SAMUEL SHARP AWARD HONORED AT CAMP RAPID

Recently, a small but significant ceremony was held at Camp Rapid to honor the recipients of the prestigious Samuel Sharp Award in recognition of their outstanding service in the South Dakota National Guard (SDNG). Chief Warrant Officer 5 (RET) Jay Schreurs and First Sgt. (RET) Greg Brower were awarded the esteemed medal.

The Ordnance Order of Samuel Sharpe, presented by the United States Army Ordnance Corps Association (USAOCA), is a highly respected accolade recognizing individuals who have demonstrated exceptional integrity, moral character, and professional competence, alongside selfless contributions to the Corps. Established in May 1994, the award is named in honor of Samuel Sharpe, the first Master Gunner of Ordnance in the Massachusetts Bay Colony.

Schreurs and Brower were celebrated for their commitment and invaluable service to the SDNG, marking their retirement with a well-deserved recognition. Their dedication and contributions to the Corps embody the values and legacy of Samuel Sharpe, making them deserving recipients of this distinguished honor.





# VA SUPPORTS MST SURVIVORS IN FINDING THEIR HEALING PATH

April is Sexual Assault Awareness and Prevention Month — an important time to reach out to veterans and other former service members and share that the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) provides free services for military sexual trauma survivors whenever they are ready, at any time of year.

Military sexual trauma, or MST, is the term the VA uses to refer to sexual assault or sexual harassment that occurred during military service. People of all sexes, ages, sexual orientations, racial, and ethnic backgrounds and branches of service have experienced MST. For some MST survivors, the experience affects their physical and mental health, work, relationships, and everyday life, even many years later.

Healing after MST can take time, and the VA understands that every survivor heals at their own pace and in their own way. That's why the VA offers free MST-related services that are tailored to each individual. The VA stands ready to help survivors on their path to heal-



ing, no matter how long it's been since they experienced MST or how it's affecting them now. There are more VA resources available for survivors of MST than ever before.

Every VA health care facility has an MST Coordinator — a professional who can assist MST survivors in accessing care. The Sioux Falls VA Health Care System's MST Coordinator is Dr. Desiree Poppens. She can be reached at 605-373-4080. The Sioux Falls VA offers free counseling and treatment to veterans and former service members for any mental or physical health condition related to their experience of MST. The VA offers flexible treatment options tailored to meet MST survivors' needs and preferences.

Community-based Vet Centers provide free MST-related outpatient counseling and referral services in a nonmedical setting. Beyond MST is a free, secure, self-help mobile app created specifically to support MST survivors' health and well-being. MentalHealth.va.gov/MST provides educational and coping resources about MST for survivors, family members, friends, and health care providers.

Eligibility for MST-related care at the VA is expansive, and no documentation of the MST experience is required to receive this care. Survivors do not need to have reported the MST experience at the time it occurred or to have sought care within a certain time frame. The VA believes MST survivors and is ready to help them heal.

All participants MUST have a valid fishing license to participate in the tournament. The total entry fee is \$300 per team or \$250 per team with a Veteran crew member. Contestants MUST check in on Friday, May 16, 2025, starting at 5:30 PM and ending at 7:30pm. LOCATION: Half Pint Steaks & Spirits; 104 3rd St SW, De Smet, SD.

#### **Tournament Payout**

1st Prize: \$5,000

2nd Prize: \$2,500

3rd Prize: \$1,200

4th Prize: \$800

5th Prize: \$500

#### TACKLE AND EQUIPMENT:

Both artificial and live bait are permitted. Each team may use up to four rods.

#### **FISHING AREA:**

The designated fishing area is Lake Thompson. Launching site is the North Ramp.

#### SCORING

Prizes will be based on pounds and ounces most weighted during the tournament day. Each boat will be permitted to catch eight walleyes. Six walleyes of at least 15 inches will be weighed, with only two over 20 inches.

#### TEAMS:

Contestants can enter as two, three, or four person teams. Tournament payouts will be awarded to the top five teams. Each team is encouraged to include Veterans as part of their crew.
